We are looking towards replacing the carpet and would like your opinions about whether or not to replace with cushioned vinyl flooring or carpet again. Included in the Saffron Mood Board is a collection of images of 'floorboards' in cushioned vinyl to give you some idea of overall 'look'. Included in the other two Boards are examples of carpet colours. The advantages of cushioned vinyl is that it is easier to maintain and adds to the insulation of the floor; the advantages of carpet is that it looks and possibly is warmer, insulates the floor and deadens sound. There are disadvantages to both!






